ABOUT THE FEDERATION

Contemporary psychoanalysis is characterized by a rich and creative pluralism in conceptualization and theory. Significant differences currently exist amongst the various theoretical and methodological positions that derive from the more contemporary orientations of: existential-humanistic, relational, transpersonal, philosophical, integrationist, and, hermeneutic psychologies - to name just a few. These various psychologies rest on different philosophical assumptions, premise different understandings as to the basic nature of people, posit different methods of knowing about people, and assume different purposes, objectives, and understandings for the analytic discourse. Psychoanalysis has been irreversibly altered by these different ways of seeing, knowing, and representing life, people, and reality as it is rethought, reinterpreted, and rewritten in the cultural context of the 21st century.

Founded in 1991, the Federation is an inclusive organization whose membership is open to anyone with a self-defined and proclaimed interest in the various discourses of psychoanalysis, such as clinical, academic, artistic, literary, or philosophical. The range of thinking that characterizes contemporary psychoanalysis has different perspectives in education, epistemology, ethics, and theory. These perspectives speak to the many equally meaningful interpretations of psychoanalytic discourse. The Federation provides the opportunity for interpretive encounters with these richly diverse and creative perspectives of the world, people, life, and psychoanalysis. A defining dimension of the Federation's uniqueness as an organization is its inclusiveness of this diversity of thinking, the threads of which are woven, at once, into the philosophical fabric of its governance structure and annual interdisciplinary conferences.

The Federation's annual conferences provide a space in the international forums of ideas in which participants have the opportunity to come forth and express their perspectives through discussion in a variety of different contexts, either formally in the panel and paper presentations or informally through other opportunities for interchange. Historically, the conference has been organized so as to provide the maximum opportunity for respectful, thoughtful and searching inquiry amongst the participants. The Federation's conference space is free of the restrictions imposed by certification and accreditation standards.

This freedom provides the maximum opportunity for discussions that mutually broaden our dialogue with other perspectives and disciplines and further psychoanalysis in its social and cultural understandings and applications.

6. Work collaboratively with other organizations in the space of our shared values.

Annual conference

IFPE sponsors a Fall conference dealing with psychoanalytic education and training in the broadest possible context. HANS W. LOEWALD MEMORIAL AWARD

Hans W. Loewald (1906-1992) was a practitioner, scholar and teacher with a deep respect for the history and complexity of psychoanalytic thought. At the same time, he was an innovator who was not afraid to challenge prevailing wisdom and to extend the boundaries of our knowledge. His collected papers and his volume on psychoanalysis and the history of the individual endure as seminal explorations of psychoanalytic theory and process, creativity and culture. IFPE established the Hans W. Loewald Memorial Award in 1993 to recognize an individual's international stature "for original and outstanding contributions to the development of psychoanalytic theory, practice, and application."
